THE WHAREPUKE/DALTON TRUST KERIKERI ARTIST IN RESIDENCE

Valued at NZ\$6,400.00, the 2026 residency is open for proposals from NZ & International artists to create a work on site for the Wharepuke Sculpture Trail in Kerikeri, New Zealand.

Proposed works **must be suitable for outdoor display** and can be 3D/2D, sculpture, installation, sound, video etc.

Artist Receives:

- **4-week residency** - between **July 15th and September 30th, 2026** - artist and Wharepuke to negotiate exact dates
- **Artist's fee \$4000.00 NZ**
- **Accommodation (valued at \$2400.00)** – self-contained one bed cottage in 5 acres of subtropical Garden of National Significance– partners/family welcome
- **Studio space if required (25m²)**
- **Outdoor 6 x 3m covered work area**
- **Artist talk** – public talk in the art gallery (optional)
- **Opening Reception** for the new work
- **Work should be a permanent installation or purposefully ephemeral for the sculpture park**
- **Web sites** – Wharepuke Sculpture Park, Art at Wharepuke & Artist Residency web page
- Selected artists may also propose to site other works for sale within the sculpture park and/or small works in the gallery.
